DR. ANTHONY LEVATINO

Former abortionist Dr. Anthony Levatino shares his unique perspective about why a physician who has been trained to give life would take it away. The story of his conversion to prolife has educated and motivated audiences worldwide.

From selfish motives to true understanding, Dr. Levatino discusses what it was like to perform abortions and the toll it took on his family until a personal tragedy occurred. Prior to his involvement in the prolife movement, Dr. Levatino performed both first and second trimester abortions as part of his OB-GYN practice in upstate New York. "I was morally neutral and believed that I had an obligation to offer complete care to my patients," states Dr. Levatino.
