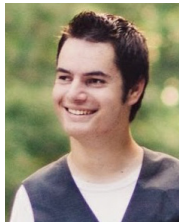

GEORGE DENNEHY

special guest speaker

After a brush with death in a Romanian orphanage, George Dennehy was adopted by his U.S. family at the age of one. Because he was born without arms, he learned to play music using his feet. Today, he is an internationally recognized songwriter and multi-instrumentalist.

George gained worldwide attention after he posted a video of himself covering the Goo Goo Dolls song “Iris” on the web. His story went global and he received media coverage from as nearby as his own hometown, and as far away as London and Sydney. The Goo Goo Dolls band invited him to open for them and perform to a crowd of 7,000 fans at Musikfest in Bethlehem, PA.

Since then, George’s career has continued to take off. He has released an original album titled *Have my Heart*, given a TED Talk, and been on television and radio all over the world. He is a husband, father, and youth pastor.
