Jaxon Strong: Celebrating a Precious Life from a Father's Perspective

Brandon Buell didn't truly recognize the purpose behind his prolife convictions until the birth of his son, Jaxon, born in 2014 with an extreme and incurable brain malformation. Before his birth, hope for Jaxon's life was nearly impossible. Abortion was suggested frequently by medical professionals who stated Jaxon may live only a few weeks—if he were to even survive delivery—and he would be significantly limited in his abilities. Through faith, Jaxon's parents chose life for their son. Against all odds, Jaxon is now five years old.
