2020 Census

- Michigan is missing 248,568 people who were killed in abortion facilities from 2010-2019.
- Michigan's Black population declined by 23,783 since 2010. Black women had 121,927 abortions from 2010-2019.
- Michigan is losing a congressional seat due to declining population. Michigan only needed an additional 5,692 people to keep the seat.
- The city of Detroit saw a massive loss of 74,666 people—most of that loss was due 60,051 abortions from 2010-2019.
- 50 of 83 Michigan counties lost population between the 2010 and 2020 censuses; 9 of those counties would have grown if not for abortion, including Wayne County.
